Evaluate

The process gaining an understanding of the whole child while they play, interact with others, and engage in learning experiences in their natural environment.

Plan

The process of gathering and organizing notes, work examples, anecdotes, family reports, and other valuable documentation to gain a view of the whole child.

Implement

Preparing individualized or group activities, learning experiences, interactions, and adding materials and equipment aimed at strengthening specific learning domains and goal areas.
